



# Sid Lucero



### DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

TOPAKK (TRIGGER) is a hardboiled action in the mold of contemporary Hong Kong action cinema, the Johnny To films in particular. The story focuses on the struggle of Miguel, a fierce Scout Ranger who suffers trauma after a savage battle against terrorists in the South of the Philippines. The traumatic experience caused his psychosis. Discharged from the military, he works as a security guard in a warehouse in Manila. When he saves a girl from syndicate villains, his otherwise peaceful new life turns deadly as the notorious hatchet man hunts them down to the end.

The vision is to trail-blaze a new trend in the action genre, as the film showcases many fight scenes. Hopefully, such direction will develop the craft of stunts and uplift the plight of stuntpeople of the Philippines movie industry.

The idea for TOPAKK came about after experiencing a series of events that shook me to my core.

I got hold up (robbery) in Quezon City when a drugged-up looking thief pointed a gun to my head. In other instances, I was chased down literally by muggers and another on public transportation.

The full-length film offers an exciting viewing experience and, at the same time, offers a view of the underworld in the Philippines. The lead protagonist, Miguel, is a compelling acting piece for any actor, essaying the challenging and complex role of someone suffering from mental dysfunction or PTSD. This aspect of the movie underlines the realistic drama of mental health, thus a discourse on the sensitive subject. My goal is to envisage a supercharged action film to be of high quality that we Filipinos can be proud of.



Born in Bacolod City, Negros Occidental with a degree and training as a Seaman, Richard V. Somes moved to Manila to pursue his other passion – film. With natural skills using paint and tools, he started out as a production designer for both film and television. Somes, under the wing of internationally known and respected Filipino director Erik Matti (On The Job, Buy Bust), his works got noticed and awarded including his production design work in the classic action–fantasy movie ANG PANDAY (2009).

With experience on the set, he ventured into directing both television and film. His work for ABS-CBN, BRIDGES OF LOVE (2015), THE STORY OF US (2016), A SOLDIER'S HEART (2020), to name a few made him a household name. In line with that, his films YANGGAW (2008), CORAZON: ANG UNANG ASWANG (2012) and EL PESTE (2018) became classics on its own right for its unique voice and attack on genre films.

WE WILL NOT DIE TONIGHT (2018), a break out success in the independent community took his career into the next level. With international festivals recognizing his hard edged aesthetics, Rob Hunter (FSR) describes the film "a grim and grimy riff on the likes of The Warriors and Judgment Night, and it's no spoiler to say that some of our protagonists most definitely will die tonight.

It's a low budget affair powered by ferocious, unrelenting action and an eye for streets running red with blood and grit, and it'll leave action junkies wanting more."

With 24 directorial credits to his name to date for both film and TV, Richard Somes is not stopping now. Even with the pandemic that literally pulled the plugged the past couple of years, he is able to finish new works in the can, KID ALPHA ONE (2022) and SENTENSYADOR (2022).

Matti says it best to describe Somes, "as a production designer and director for films, Richard Somes is a master of textures. If Pantera and Nine Inch Nails formed a band, the music that will come out of it would be like a Somes set design: gritty, theatrical, chaotic, metallic, in your face and uber gaudy with a double wink at humor only he and the ones who know him can fully understand."

TOPAKK, his latest film, has received initial grant money from the Film Development Council of the Philippines. The collaboration with his producers and creative team makes TOPAKK his most ambitious opus to date.

### PRODUCER'S STATEMENT


Writer-Director Richard V. Somes has been a prolific filmmaker in the Philippines. I've personally worked with him on various highly rated television shows for ABS-CBN in my early years and have tracked his career ever since. His staple award-winning genre films has given him a unique voice in Philippine cinema. His most successful high-octane martial arts movie to date, We Will Not Die Tonight, introduced him to the world stage.

TOPAKK with its political and social themes, exposes a lot of what is happening in the Philippines, especially during the height of the war on drugs. Even with the violence portrayed in the script, the project looks deep into the morals of the players – the addicts, the pushers, the protectors, and even the politicians – blurring the lines and looking at them as victims of a vicious dangerous cycle. TOPAKK is a relevant topic now and a discourse that's universal with drugs and gun violence increasing all over the world.

As a producer, I'm confident the film will take Richard Somes next to the growing genre filmmakers coming from South East Asia. His aesthetics and sensibilities as a Filipino director is a new breed, a loud voice coming from a country with much political divide and growing turmoil.
